

# Trade Policy After the U.S. Elections

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


## **Election Summary**

- Donald J. Trump elected 45<sup>th</sup> President
  - Hillary Clinton wins popular vote
- GOP retains control of both House and Senate
  - Smaller majorities than in 114th Congress
- GOP controls at least 33 Governorships
  - Most since the 1920's
- GOP controls 36 State Senates and 32 State Houses



#### **Presidential Election**






# 115<sup>th</sup> Congress - House

Total 435




# 115<sup>th</sup> Congress - Senate

- Identify every trade barrier
- Renegotiate NAFTA
- Label China a currency manipulator
- Bring trade cases/impose tariffs against China
