SAMBURU

Dramatic landscapes in Northern Kenya teeming with Wildlife

Samburu National Reserve is one of the lesser-known national parks, but is nevertheless teeming with life. Situated at the south eastern corner of Samburu District in the Rift Valley Province of Kenya alongside the Ewaso Nyiro River, there is plenty to attract wildlife from the surrounding savannah plains.

A red landscape dominated by acacia-grassland mosaic, with dramatic dry upland/montane forests rising from its plains, it is home to a wide diversity of species. Inhabited by pastoral tribes with rich traditional histories that are collectively striving both to protect its ecological integrity and their own livelihoods there is no better way for visitors to experience the real Africa.

The reserve is rich in wildlife with an abundance of rare northern specialist species such as the Grevy's zebra, Somali ostrich, reticulated giraffe, gerenuk and the beisa oryx (also referred to as Samburu Special Five). The reserve is also home to elephants and large predators such as the lion, leopard and cheetah. Kamunyak the miracle lioness that adopted the baby oryx was as a resident in the reserve. Wild dog sightings are also a common attraction to this unique protected area. Birdlife is abundant with over 450 species recorded.

Two packages are offered here to give you options to consider for the Samburu area, at Saruni Samburu and at Samburu Intrepids. Bookings are on a space available basis and although not as busy as the Masai Mara at this time of year, demand is high due to the season and bookings are encouraged as soon as possible. Additional nights can be added or alternative options are available on a bespoke basis.

SARUNI SAMBURU, KALAMA CONSERVANCY (3 Nights Full Board)

Saruni Samburu is located at the heart of the Kalama Community Wildlife Conservancy, about 7 km from the Northern border of the Samburu National Reserve. Centered around a core conservation area of 3,150 hectares, Kalama represents a crucial migratory corridor between northern and southern conservation areas of this spectacular region of Kenya. Large herds of elephants cross Kalama in their migratory routes between the different conservancies that are under the NRT umbrella.

Kalama members have coexisted with the Samburu National Reserve for over 40 years, sharing revenues and wildlife. Northern Kenya is one of Africa's last true wilderness areas. The absence of fences makes it one of the few places left that allows for the free movement of wildlife across a vast area.

Enjoy a 3 night safari on a full board basis including drinks at Saruni Samburu. The trip includes internal flights, transfers to / from the airport and Conservancy fees. Activities include game drives into Samburu National Reserve, guided walks on the conservancy, day and night game drives on the conservancy, sundowners, bush breakfasts, cultural visits or make the most of their relaxing wellness area.

Samburu Intrepids is a lush oasis on the banks of the great Uaso Nyiro River in Samburu Game Reserve. The tented luxury camp sits on raised decks overlooking the brown river where the elephants sometimes make an appearance or the crocodiles come out to lounge by the river's banks.

Join up in a group of four to enjoy a 2 night driving safari on a full board basis to this Northern reserve. The trip includes transport by vehicle and Conservancy fees. During the visit you will enjoy game drives and be able to relax by the pool.

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NAIVASHA

Drive through the Great Rift Valley to enjoy a taste of wildlife, a round of golf or a relaxing excursion on the shores of Lake Naivasha

Lake Naivasha lies to the north west of Nairobi, approximately one and a half hour's drive away through the spectacular Great Rift Valley. The Lake Naivasha area is a UNESCO natural heritage site for the prolific birdlife of over 400 different species. For the last two decades Naivasha has been well known for the flower farms, yet it is also ideal for bird watching and exploring the shores where wildlife is found in private sanctuaries.

A trip to Naivasha gives you many opportunities, a bush experience with a visit to a world-class flower farm; or the opportunity to focus on your golf at the beautiful course; or to simply relax and enjoy the beautiful lakeside environment.

From a wildlife perspective, although not as spectacular as the large reserves of the Masai Mara, Samburu and Amboseli, a trip to Naivasha will give you a taster of the wildlife experience and is very easily accessible for shorter trip – or a stop-over on the way to the Masai Mara.

Three options for golf, wildlife viewing or simply relaxing are offered around Lake Naivasha. Bookings are on a space available basis and these packages are all quoted on the basis of a group of four people or more. Additional nights can be added or alternative options are available on a bespoke basis.

CHUI LODGE, NAIVASHA (2 Nights Full Board)

The Wildlife sanctuary surrounding Chui Lodge was created in the mid 1990's with the sole purpose of giving the resident wildlife a place of safety and refuge. Over 18,000 acres is surrounded by an electrified fence, as much to keep illegal cattle grazers out as it to keep the wildlife from straying into the nearby farms. The wildlife are still able to move freely between the neighbouring Hell's Gate National Park, the sanctuary and the lake shore by way of wildlife corridors which ensures constant movement throughout the localized eco-system.

Since the creation of the sanctuary and the wildlife corridors the number of wildlife, specifically species such as leopard and giraffe, persecuted by the villagers in the past, has stabilized and increased to sustainable levels.

Whilst lions do occasionally visit, there is a pressing need to “predator proof” the fence surround Oserengoni Wildlife Sanctuary and to turn our sporadic predator presence into a full time programme. This will allow natural control of the ever increasing numbers of certain herbivore species within the sanctuary.

Join up as a group of four or more to enjoy a 2 night driving trip to Naivasha staying on a full board basis the luxurious Chui Lodge. The trip includes transport from Nairobi and within the Conservancy as well as Conservancy fees. While there you can go on game drives, bush walks, boat rides on the lake and visit a flower farm.

Nestled in the volcanic hills and open grasslands on the western edge of Lake Naivasha in the Great Rift Valley, Mundui House is the perfect romantic escape or weekend getaway for couples, families and friends.

The lawns, which slope down to the lake shore, are a favourite hangout and grazing spot for warthog, antelope, zebra, giraffe, hippo, buffalo and many species of birds. One of the oldest houses around the lake, Mundui House has an interesting history and visitors such as Ernest Hemingway and Winston Churchill have stayed on the historic property. The spacious house and its position on the ARR Conservancy make it the perfect venue for a relaxing few days.

Take time out to relax with a 2 night trip to Mundui house on a full board basis. The trip includes transport from Nairobi and a myriad of choices of activities from game drives to helicopter excursions to horse riding to spa treatments if you want to do more than enjoy the gardens and lake.

From its panoramic perch above Lake Naivasha, the Great Rift Valley Lodge enjoys one of human kind's oldest views – over the sweeping floor of the World's largest valley. The Lodge is built on the Eburru, a mountain that the Masai call Ol Donyo Oporru, meaning mountain of smoke. The Lodge sits at about 7,000 feet, from which elevation it enjoys magnificent views to the west and east. The vistas stretch from the sparkling waters of Lake Naivasha to the jagged volcanic crater of Mount Longonot and, beyond, the sloping shoulders of the Aberdare Mountains – Kenya's most important watershed.

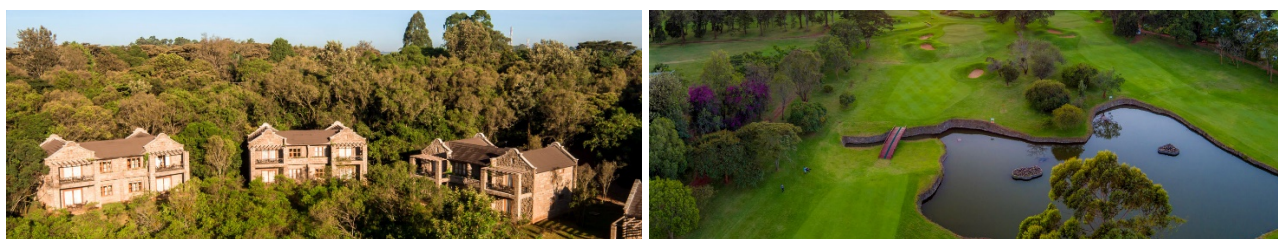

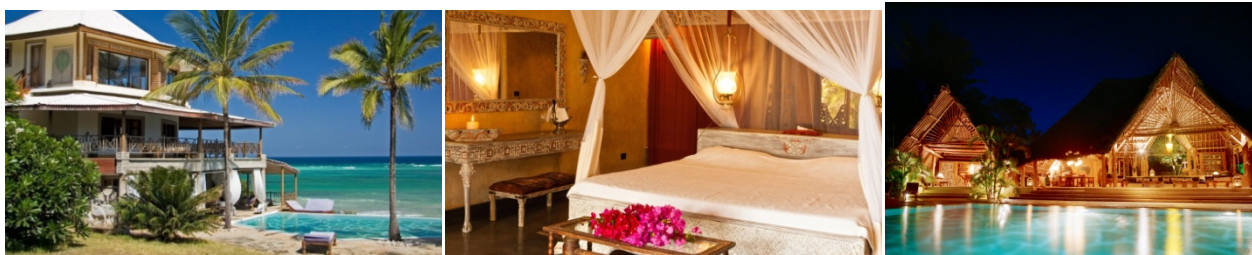
